The program provides an accessible, hands-on introduction to cybersecurity concepts designed for nontechnical learners, supporting safe technology use, workforce readiness, and exploration of cybersecurity career pathways.

- 2. Identify and respond appropriately to online threats such as phishing, scams, and identity theft.
