

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

Students may earn credit for College Entrance Examination Board (CEEB) Advanced Placement (AP) Tests with scores of 3, 4, or 5. AP credit can be used to meet IGETC, CSU GE and A.A. general Education (GE) and/or major requirements.

Official test scores must be submitted to Coastline's Admissions and Records Office. Students must have the College Board send AP exam results to the Admissions Office (hand carried copies will not be accepted) for use on the A.A. or GE patterns.

Transfer Students: Course credit and units granted at Coastline College may differ from course credit and units granted by a transfer institution.
