PREREQUISITE: DANC A215. ADVISORY: DANC A129 or DANC A153 or DANC A229. Recommendation: Ideally, the second level of internship should be taken after or at the same time as DANC A129 Pilates Methodology or concurrently with DANC A229 Pilates Methodology 2. Transfer Credit: CSU.
