Course Description

This noncredit course provides Lifeguard Basic Academy training for aspiring emergency responders interested in career opportunities as aquatic rescuers, either within lifeguard agencies or the fire service. This rigorous academy includes lecture and field training in the ocean environment and follows the United States Lifesaving Association required course curriculum for Aquatic Rescue Response Teams and Open Water Lifeguard Certification. Training will include; marine weather, aquatic hazards, communications, lifesaving rescue techniques, specialized equipment use, night rescues, medical aid, and interaction with the public. To successfully complete the academy, students must be athletically fit with strong swimming skills.
