Voter Registration

- Online (<https://registertovote.ca.gov/>) by February 20, 2024
- By Mail, postmark by February 20, 2024
- You can "conditionally" register (<https://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/voter-registration/same-day-reg/>) and vote at your county elections office after the 15-day voter registration deadline.

All California active registered voters will receive a vote-by-mail ballot for the March 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election Completed Ballots, Including Vote-by-Mail Ballots

- Personally delivered ballots: Must be delivered by close of polls on March 5, 2024
- Mailed ballots: Must be postmarked on Election Day and received by March 12, 2024.
