## Election Dates 2024-2025

Presidential General Election – November 5, 2024

### Voter Registration

- Online or postmarked by October 21, 2024
- All California active voters will receive a vote-by-mail ballot for the November 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election.
- You can “conditionally” register and vote at your county elections office after the 15-day voter registration deadline.

### Completed Ballots, Including Vote-by-Mail Ballots

- Personally delivered ballots: Must be delivered no later than the “Close of polls” time of 8:00pm on November 5, 2024.
- Mailed ballots: Must be postmarked on or before November 5, 2024, and received by your county elections office no later than 7 days after Election Day on November 12, 2024.
