

ADMISSIONS AND REGISTRATION

We want to make enrolling at Orange Coast College as convenient and easy as possible. It begins when the student completes and files an application form online at www.orangecoastcollege.edu (<http://www.orangecoastcollege.edu>)

Students that are new to Orange Coast College complete an online orientation.

New students complete the Assessment process in order to receive placement into English and Math courses. This process may include submission of a transcript (to determine Math and English course placement), self reporting of high school GPA (if no transcripts are available) or placement through a guided self-placement. In addition, new students may schedule an appointment to meet with a counselor to create a Student Education Plan (SEP) and verify their program of study (major).
