LRNG A001 **1-3 Units (54-162 lab hours)**

Basic Skills Remediation

Prerequisite(s): Completion of the California Community College Learning Disabilities Assessment.

Grading Mode: Pass/No Pass

Provides individualized remedial instruction to students with learning disabilities. The program is designed to help a student improve the basic academic skills of reading, spelling, writing and arithmetic. This is an open entry/open exit course. NOT DEGREE APPLICABLE.

To increase writing skills and preparation for transferable English courses, students will practice specific learning strategies, employ assistive technologies related to writing, and receive individualized instruction.
