

RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY

The Radiologic Technology program is a full-time (21-month including one summer session and two intersessions) program of study. A Radiologic Technologist acquires images of human anatomy for diagnostic use by a Radiologist or other medical specialist. Graduates of the program are eligible for certification by examination through the American Registry of Radiologist Technologists and to apply for licensing by the Department of Public Health Services in Sacramento. Graduates are also able to enroll in post-graduate courses leading to certification by examination in Computed Tomography and Mammography.
